

## Ivy Hills Annual Meeting

Abbreviated business meeting minutes:

1. Approval of the Sept. 19, 2018 minutes will be held until the Jan. 2019 board meeting.
2. Katie Sammon gave a brief report and went over the budget for 2019. Katie Sammon motioned to approve the budget for 2019 and the motion was seconded by Rhonda Hughes. Budget was approved /passed unanimously.
3. New Business:
  - a. Entrance signage at 79<sup>th</sup> & Allisonville received updated landscaping and stone caps were ordered & received for the brick columns. They will be placed as soon as a reliable mason can commit to the job. The white wooden portion of the sign on the south side will need to be replaced as the boards are rotting.
  - b. Discussion took place for potential new signage in additional areas of the neighborhood lead by Greg McMullen. (Some possible areas for placement are: 75<sup>th</sup> & Camelback, Kilmer & Allisonville, Attleboro, Pawtucket and Cape Cod). Greg has an example of a smaller sign and he will work on getting estimates for this new signage.
  - c. A few neighbors expressed an interest in moving the annual picnic to Sunday from 4-6 pm vs. Saturday from 12-3 pm. Amber will explore this option a little more and we may put a survey on the FB page for feedback on the proposed change.
