Impact your neighbors. Impact your community. Impact your world!

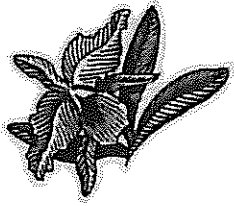

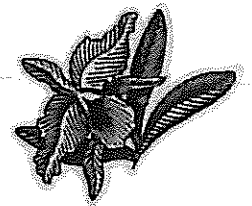

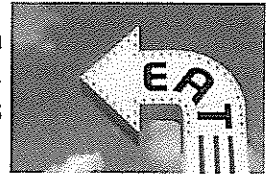

## Bragging about BRAG

### A Message from our Binford Redevelopment and Growth Liaison

Hello Fellow Residents of Ivy Hills,

My name is Greg Geller and I have lived in Ivy Hills for over 5 years now. I am originally from NYC and lived in Seattle for 13 years before moving to Indianapolis in 2003 with my wife and 2 daughters (we now have 3). I decided that, if I am going to live here the rest of my life, I want to get involved in the community. So I chose to be the BRAG Liaison for our neighborhood. Basically what this means is I go to the monthly meetings and report back the news and events surrounding this meeting. If there's anything specific you want me to focus on or push for, please tell me. The best way to reach me is via email – [gellerg@wwdb.org](mailto:gellerg@wwdb.org). For those of you who do not know what BRAG (Binford Redevelopment And Growth) is, here is a quick summary...

It started simple – redevelop the Binford Boulevard corridor from 75<sup>th</sup> to 62<sup>nd</sup>. It has since grown to encompass from Sargent Road on the east, 82<sup>nd</sup> Street on the north, Dean Road on the west and 56<sup>th</sup> Street and Fall Creek Road on the south. This is how Ivy Hills and 30 other neighborhoods have come to be a part of this effort. The BRAG website is great – [www.binford71.org](http://www.binford71.org) – and because of this effort in attracting businesses to this area, it is important that we shop these businesses so they flourish and attract more and more traffic and attention.

There are a lot of BRAG initiatives going on now. The two that speak to me are the InStepp initiative (Indy Northside Sidewalks & Trails Engaging People with Places) & Indy Connect. Both are transportation related. Instepp is in the process of providing a safe passage from Hague to Allisonville on 71<sup>st</sup> and 75<sup>th</sup> street. Indy Connect is looking at ways to enhance travel in Indianapolis with the study of looking to set up a commuter rail in the Northeast corridor from Fishers to Downtown & from Cumberland to the Airport.

There are many, many ways BRAG is impacting our community in a positive way.

This past year, BRAG has hired a **Development Director, Alison McConnell**, she can be reached at [Alison@binford71.org](mailto:Alison@binford71.org) and she happens to be an Ivy Hills Resident.
